## **CALL FOR PEER REVIEWERS**

The Council for American Students in International Negotiations (CASIN), along with the Advisory Board of *Eyes on the International Criminal Court*, is currently seeking applications for the position of Peer Reviewer. *Eyes on the ICC is* the first peer-reviewed, scholarly journal devoted to the study of the International Criminal Court. This publication seeks to advance the understanding of the ICC as well as promote positive relations between the international criminal law community and the United States.

**Duties:** Peer reviewers are expected to review manuscripts submitted by authors, give constructive comments, and determine the manuscript's suitability for publication and contribution to the field. All tasks will be completed remotely, via email. Members will be identified according to their availability and expertise.

**Compensation:** All positions with *Eyes on the ICC* are performed on a volunteer basis. The position of Peer Reviewer is thoroughly rewarding: benefits include the satisfaction of producing high-quality scholarly work, engaging with top scholars, and working with highly motivated staff.

**Qualifications:** Candidates should have strong writing skills and a demonstrated interest and background in international criminal law, humanitarian law, human rights law, or another relevant field. Junior level faculty members, human rights scholars, and practitioners are especially encouraged to apply. Applicants should have a minimum of 3-5 years of relevant academic experience in their field. Candidates should be available to assume their titles immediately.

How to Apply: Applications should include a one-page letter of interest, 3-5 key areas of focus (i.e. genocide studies, Cambodia, international criminal law, etc.), curriculum vitae, and list of publications. These materials should be emailed as .doc or .pdf attachments to icc@americanstudents.us. Please identify the title of the position for which you are applying as the subject of your email.

**Deadline**: Applications are accepted on a rolling basis.
